
Modular Bedroom: Internal robe drw (Single/Double)



• Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.

• Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

• Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

• Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

• During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

• Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

• Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

• Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

• Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners. • From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

• This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.


Handy Hints


• Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts • Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightend properly.

If you have damaged or missing components, return to your local store.






Step 4


Fitting bottom panel

Slide drawer bottom panel into groove.




Step 5

Insert 2 wooden dowels (A) on drawer side panels (1) as shown. Then connect it to front panel (3).






Insert 4 locking nuts D into drawer side panels
1 where shown.
Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts D clockwise to lock.



Step 7


Carefully fix drawer bottom panel 4 using 4 back fittings by pushing it into the groove on drawer back 2 and front panel 4. Once fitting in place carefully secure by tighten screw.



Step 8

Fixing spacer on slides


Fix 4 rail plate \bigcirc to slides \bigcirc (1RH + 1LH).



Step 9

Fitting rails

Fix 1 set of drawer rails O on side panels 1 using 4 screws O. The lowest position to install a drawer in a robe is 4 holes up from the base as shown. Between each drawer there needs to be 6 holes before securing another drawer rail.




DRAWER LAY OUT EXAMPLE:



Step 10

Fitting drawer

Slide drawer box on to rails until it locks in position. Be sure that drawer box fits correctly as shown.



Step 11

To prevent the drawer from lifting off the runner it is fitting with a locking mechanism.

To secure, you will need to pull the pin out and rotate 90degree upwards and then push pin back towards the runner
