Operating instructions

- 1. Unpack the product and accessories from the packaging.
- 2. Assemble the stake and stand tube with the connector.
- 3. Insert the stake in the selected ground location.
- 4. Connect the cord into the supplied adaptor, then plug the adaptor into a mains socket.
- 5. Adjust the lamp up or down to get the projection in your desired location.
- 6. Unplug the transformer when not in use.
