Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly.






- This product is made from toughened glass, which is strong but not unbreakable. In the unlikely event that the glass fails, it will break into a large number of small fragments that may be spread over a wide area. This is a feature of toughened glass, and is designed to remove the risk of injury from glass breaking into large shards.
- If the glass is chipped or broken, stop using the product.
- Tables should not be dragged at any time.
- Do not strike or place heavy weight on the table.
- Do not place hot items directly onto the glass.
- Avoid dropping objects on the glass, as this may weaken or shatter it.
- Do not use the glass as a chopping surface.
- Do not strike the glass with hard or pointed items.
- Check you have all the components and tools listed in this booklet before assembly.
- Remove all fittings from their plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area; small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting.
- Do not stand or put weight on the component parts during assembly, as this could cause damage.
- Assemble on a soft, level surface to avoid damaging the table or your floor.
- We recommend a two-person assembly.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Regularly check all the bolts, screws and fastenings are secure.
- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent; do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.



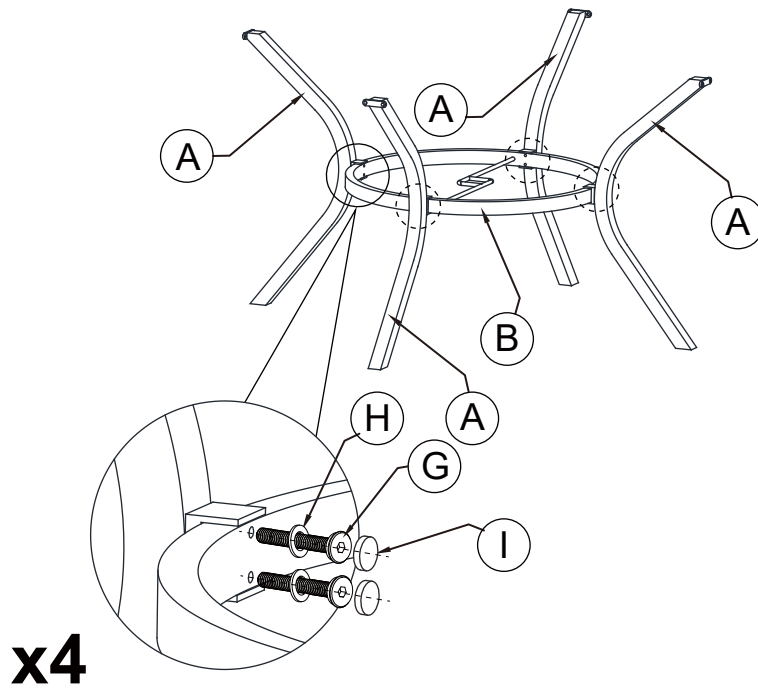

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ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

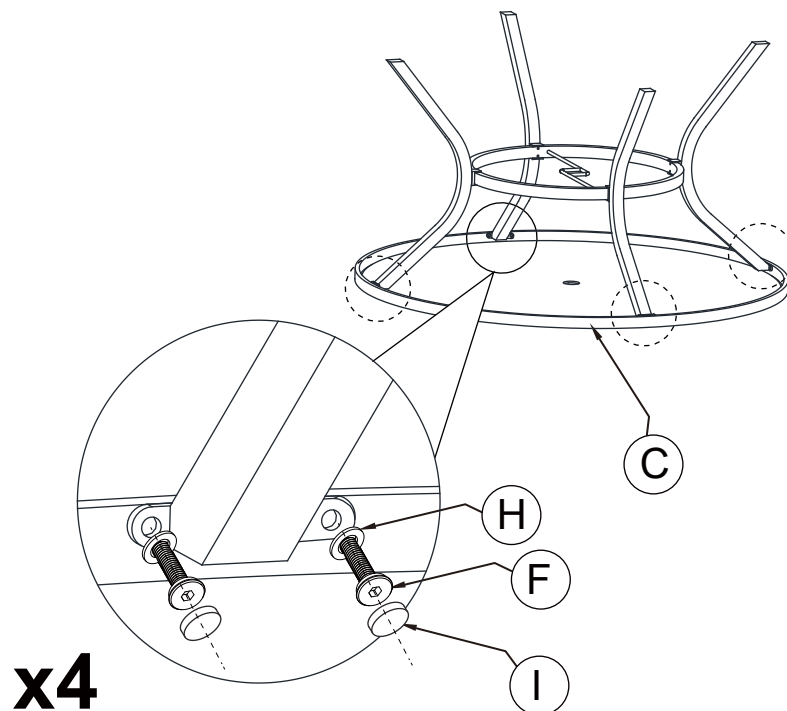
Step 1

Use screws **G** and washers **H** to fix the table legs **A** to the support rim **B**. Do not fully tighten all the screws until assembly is complete.



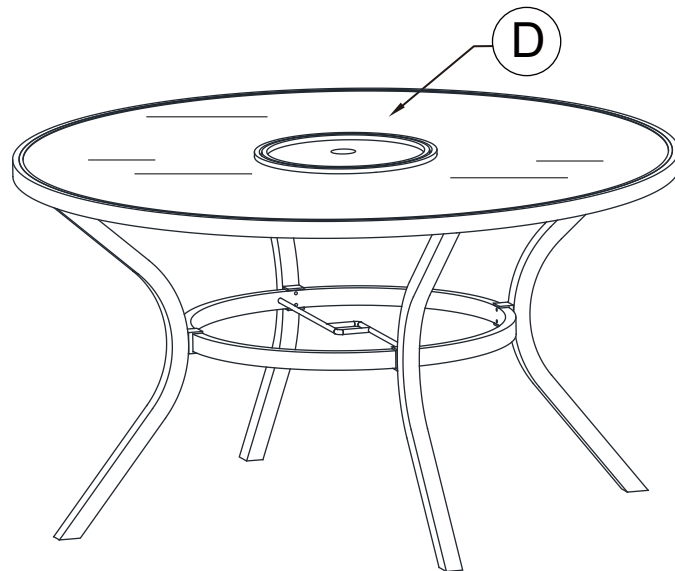
Step 2

Use screws **F** and washers **H** to fix the table rim **C** to the unit. Fully tighten all the screws then cover all the screws with caps **I**.



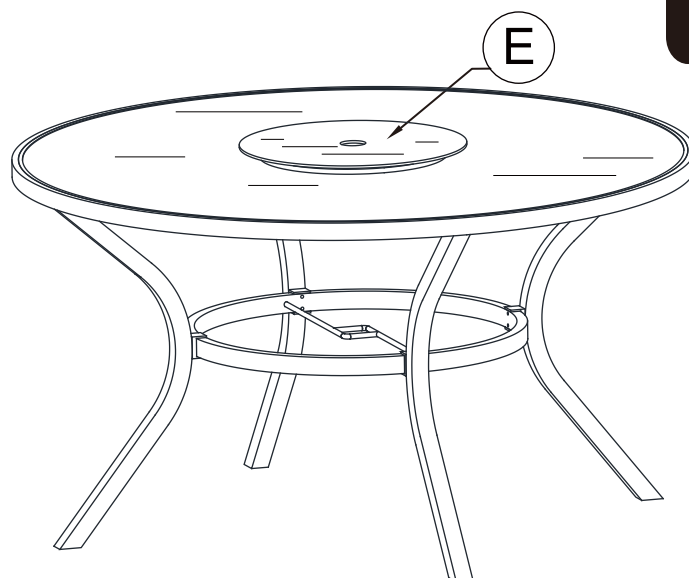
Step 3

Carefully place the Lazy Susan base **D** onto the table rim **C**.



Step 4

Carefully place the Lazy Susan top **E** onto the Lazy Susan base.



WARNING!

IF USING A PARASOL, USE A WEIGHTED BASE AND REMOVE THE PARASOL IN WINDY CONDITIONS. PARASOLS CAN PUT PRESSURE ON THE TABLE TOP OR EVEN BLOW THE TABLE OVER IN WINDY WEATHER.
