CARE ADVICE

- Always close/put down the parasol when not in use. Do not use or assemble the parasol in wind, rain, thunderstorms or if it's snowing. In these weather conditions, we recommend to fold down or disassemble the parasol. Disassemble by following the setup steps in this manual.
- The parasol must be secured in place using a parasol base. Make sure the ground is level and firm.
- If the crank gets too hard to turn, check if the rope has come off the pulley. If you continue to turn the crank, the rope or crank handle could break.
- Placing the parasol over or near a swimming pool can cause premature fading of the canopy.

WARNING

- Do not assemble the parasol on sandy, muddy or loose soil.
- Keep children and pets away while setting up the parasol.
- Children must be supervised around the parasol.
- This parasol is for outdoor use only.
- Do not light any fires under or near the parasol!
- This parasol is primarily intended to be used as a sunshade and not as wind protection.

CARE FOR THE CANOPY



- Simply clean the umbrella canopy with a soft brush and mild detergent.
- Do not machine wash or machine dry.
- Do not iron.
- Air-dry the canopy thoroughly in an open position before storing for extended periods of time.

ATTENTION

- Please read these instructions carefully before assembly.
- Although assembly only requires 1 person, it is advised that a second person be present to help place into position when fully assembled.

COMPONENTS


Please check you have all components listed below. If you have any missing or damaged components, please contact your local store.

A	 A long, narrow metal base with a central slot and two circular holes at the ends.	1 x Cross Base A
B	 A long, narrow metal base with a central slot and two circular holes at the ends, similar to A but with a different profile.	1 x Cross Base B
C	 A long, thin metal pole with a hook-like end on the left and a flange with two circular holes on the right.	1 x Support Pole
D	 A bolt and a hexagonal nut. φM8*20mm	4 x Bolts
E	 A flat, circular washer with a central hole.	4 x Washers
F	 A simple open-end wrench.	1 x Wrench
G	 A complete assembly of a frame with a canopy, showing multiple curved ribs and a central support structure.	1 x Frame with Canopy

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


Step 1

Place Cross Base (A) on a soft surface, line up notches and place Cross Base (B) over Cross Base (A).




Step 2

Attach Support Pole (C) to Cross Base by using Bolts (D) and Washers (E), hand tighten only. Adjust the Support Pole (C) to be sure it is positioned correctly on the Cross Base and finally tighten all Bolts with Wrench (F). Be careful not to over tighten.



Step 3


Insert the Parasol (G) into Support Pole (C).



Do not install the fixer at the same side of the canopy to make it stable.


Step 4

Unlock the clip to raise the canopy arm.




Step 5

Ensure the clip is locked into place to secure the canopy arm in position.




Step 6

Turn the crank handle in a clockwise direction to open the parasol canopy.




Step 7

Turn the crank handle counter clockwise to close the parasol.




Step 8

DO NOT JUST FOLD DOWN SUDDENLY, OR THE PLASTIC PART (L) WILL BE EASILY BROKEN.
