

# Safety and Care Advice

#### Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting assembly.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the product as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft, level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product, please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torque setting.

#### Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time-to-time check that there are no loose screws on this product.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste.
  Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

### **Handy hints**


- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts.
- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.












3 Lower divisions x 2 (20 x 49cm)



Shelf (holes on both sides) x 1 (86.4 x 49cm)




Upper divisions (holes on both sides) x 2 (20 x 49cm)


### Step 1

# Preparing lower division panels

Insert 2 wooden dowels into each lower division panel 3.

#### Note:


You can choose to assemble this unit directly inside the wardrobe, or separately and then place it.

## Fixing lower divisions to shelf


Connect the shelf 2 with the lower divisions 3 using the dowels.

# Preparing upper division panels


Insert 2 wooden dowels **A** into each upper division panel **4**.

## Fixing upper divisions to shelf


Connect the shelf 2 with the upper divisions 4 using the dowels.



## Step 5


#### **Connecting top panel**

Connect the top panel 1 to the rest of the structure.



The structure can then be placed into the wardrobe.

Take care when moving: Lift the structure via the lower divisions.

## Insert the structure into the wardrobe

Carefully insert the structure into the wardrobe:
