
Fitted Bedrooms: Internal Wardrobe Drawer (Single/Double)

Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting assembly.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the product as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft, level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product, please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time-to-time check that there are no loose screws on this product.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste.
 Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

Handy hints


- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts.
- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.






Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws

Step 1

Preparing panels


Screw 8 metal dowels into drawer front panel and back panel 2.



Step 2


Fixing drawer structure

Insert 2 wooden dowels into drawer side panels 1. Then connect them to drawer back panel 2.



Step 3

Insert 4 locking nuts **①** into drawer side panels **1**, as shown.
Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts **①** clockwise to lock.



Step 4

Placing bottom panel

Slide drawer bottom panel

into grooves.

Step 5

Fixing front panel


Insert 2 wooden dowels **(A)** on drawer side panels **(1)**, as shown.

Then connect it to front panel 3.

Step 6

Insert 4 locking nuts **D** into drawer side panels **1**, as shown.


Use a screwdriver to turn locking nuts **①** clockwise to lock.



Step 7

Fixing bottom panel

Carefully fix drawer bottom panel 4 using 4 back fittings 6. Slot panel into the grooves on drawer back 2 and front panel 3. Once placed carefully secure by tightening the screw.



Step 8

Fixing spacer panels for rails

Fix spacer panels 5 and 6 to the wardrobe side panels, using 2 screws for each one.




ATTENTION:

To avoid obstruction with door hinges, install the drawer starting from the 4th hole up from the base, as shown.

Do NOT use the following holes:


1, 2, 3, 25, 26, 27, 40, 41, 42




Step 9

Fixing rails

Fix rails **G** to spacers **5** and **6**, using 2 screws **G** for each.






Step 10

Fitting drawer


Slide drawer box onto rails until it locks into position. Pull out the locking mechanism to allow the drawer to take position. Be sure that drawer box fits correctly, as shown.



Step 11

To prevent the drawer from lifting off the runner it must be secured with the locking mechanism.


To secure, you will need to push the pin back towards the runner.



Step 12

Drawer height adjustment

If you want to lift or to lower the drawer, please rotate the specific paddle on the rails. (Make the same gradual adjustment on both the rails).



Drawer on divider storage

35.4cm drawers can also be installed on the divider storage unit, once inside the wardrobe.

Repeat the previous steps for the drawer installation. (Return to step 8).

Avoid installing the drawer spacers any higher than the 5th hole under the shelf, to ensure you don't obstruct the hinges.



ATTENTION:

Wardrobe side panel:

To avoid obstruction with door hinges, install the drawer starting from the 4th hole up from the base, as shown previously (Step 8). Do NOT use the following holes:

1, 2, 3, 25, 26, 27, 40, 41, 42
